Uniform Policy

Shirts for Middle School

- Acceptable Shirt Styles for Middle School Students Are:
 - Short or long sleeve polos or turtlenecks in approved colors that are long enough to be tucked into bottoms.
- **REMEMBER** - Shirts are to be tucked into the pants at all times!



Shirts for Middle School Students

- Shirt colors for grades K-8 are as follows
Navy Blue, Hunter Green/Evergreen,
White, Red, Pink/Ice Pink.
- No Stripes, No Plaids, No Oxfords

- Acceptable Shirt Styles for High School Are:
 - Any color or stripe Polo or Oxford Style Shirt – no plaid.
- Shirt colors for High School Students (grades 9 - 11 only) are not specified.

Boys Pants – All Grades

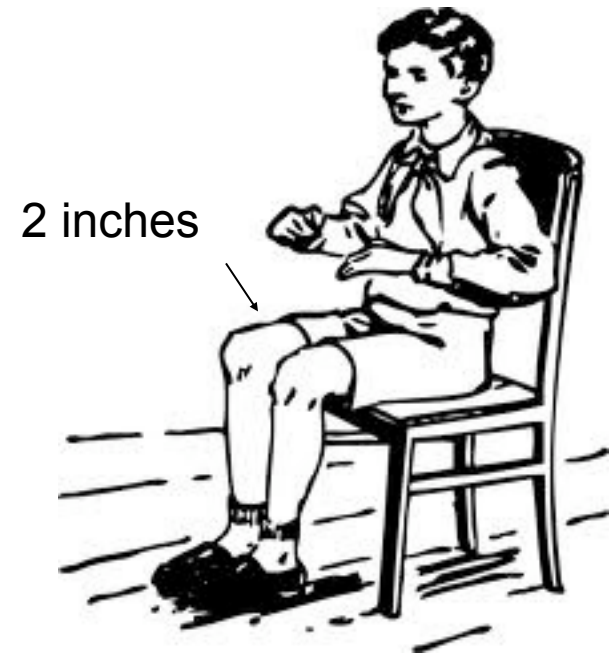
The approved colors for trousers are khaki and navy blue. All clothing should be modestly loose without being oversized.



- Plain Front Pants or Shorts
- Pleated Front Pants or Shorts
- Cargo Pants or Shorts

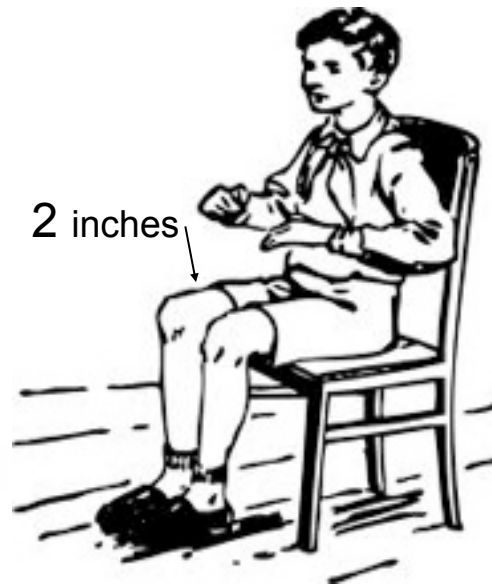
Boys Pant Fit

- Pants need to fit and remain over the hipbone at all times. No baggy pants!
- Shorts should be no shorter than 2" above the knee when in sitting position.



Girls' Pants, Crops/Capris, Shorts, Skirts and Jumpers

- Pants should fit conservatively in nature. No tight pants are allowed. All bottom wear should fit over the hip bones. Skirts, and shorts should be no shorter than 2" above the knee when in sitting position.
- With skirts and jumpers, it is suggested that girls should wear matching color bike shorts under their skirts to promote modesty.

Socks

- Students must wear socks, tights, at all times.
- Nylons or leggings are acceptable for girls in grades 6 and up
- Colors for socks will not be specified;
- Tights and leggings shall be of any color for high school and navy, dark green, white, red, and pink for middle

Shoes

- Athletic shoes may be worn daily.
- Acceptable colors for all styles of shoes are white, black, brown, gray or navy blue. This includes laces!
- The shoes may have no lights, patterns or characters on them. Appropriate manufacturer logos are acceptable.
- Shoes should have closed toe and closed heel.
- Boots may be worn when weather indicates.
- No heels greater than 1 inch.
- No Slippers or Slipper-like Shoes

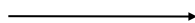
Belts

- Belts must be worn with all pants. Belts should be solid black or brown leather or similar material.

Sweaters and RMCA Spirit Wear Hoodies

- Sweaters and RMCA Spirit Wear “Hoodies” may be worn in the classroom. Appropriate Sweaters may have a hood and zipper.
- Only RMCA “Hoodies” may be worn in the classroom
- No other type of “Hoodie” may be worn in the classroom
- You must wear a uniform shirt under “Hoodies” or sweaters.
- You may not wear coats or jackets in the building.

Other

- Appropriate undergarments must be worn and not visible.
- Make-up may not be worn until the 7th grade and must be conservative in nature.
- Tattoos and body piercing, other than girls' earrings, are not allowed.
- Large dangling or hoop-type earrings are not allowed.
- Earrings must be limited to 1 earring per ear. Jewelry other than watches for boys or girls, and small earrings on girls, may not be worn. Necklaces may be worn but should be inside the shirt.
- Boys may not wear earrings.
- No cross gender dressing.

Other, continued

- Hairstyle and hair color must be conservative in nature.
- Boys' hair must not extend below the top of the shirt collar in the back, the bottom of the ears on the sides or the eyebrows in front.
- No mohawks, “fauxhawks” or dreadlocks. No braids on boys.
- Pants may not have holes in the knees.
- No pocket chains or hats may be worn in the building.
- Undershirts may be worn under the uniform shirt but may not show.
- Vests are not allowed.

Jean Days

- Jean Days are the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of Every Month
- You may pay \$1.00 to wear jeans on these days.
- Proper Uniform Shirts Must be worn on jean days.
- Shirts need to stay tucked in
- Belts must be worn
- No torn, ripped or holey jeans
- No skinny jeans, No tight jeans
- No baggy jeans



Dress Up Days (Sports)

- Dress up for sports days requires uniform or better.
 - No jeans or denim
 - No high heels
 - Skirts should be within 2” of knee when seated.
 - No spaghetti straps
 - Dress clothes should be of proper fit and modest.

Please remember

- RMCA is a school of choice = you chose to come here and RMCA is a uniform school so logic follows that you chose to wear a uniform.
- Failure to abide by the uniform policy will result in contact with parents.
- Continued failure to abide by the uniform policy will result in detentions or suspensions.
